Amid the shouts of "Hosanna to the Son of David" we know You as the Suffering Servant of God.


Through the waving palm branches we see You as the King of our peace.

Zechariah 9:9–12






APOSTLES' CREED




People and also that we, being defended from the fear of our enemies, may live in peace and quietness;
